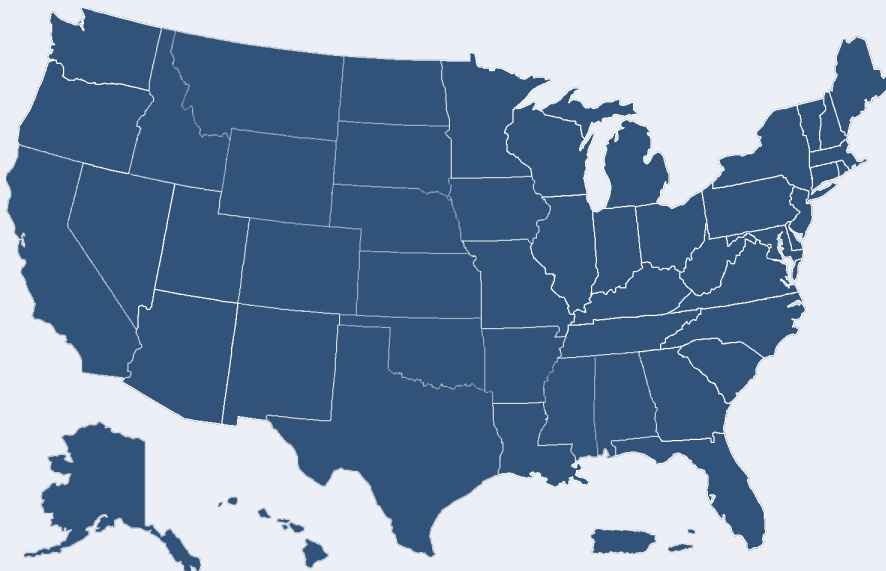


OVERDOSE RESPONSE STRATEGY

The Overdose Response Strategy is an unprecedented and unique collaboration between public health and public safety, created to help local communities reduce drug overdoses and save lives by sharing timely data, pertinent intelligence and innovative strategies.



The ORS is implemented by teams made up of **Drug Intelligence Officers** and **Public Health Analysts**, who work together on drug overdose issues within and across sectors, states and territories. By sharing information across sectors, the ORS is growing the body of evidence related to **early warning signs** and **prevention strategies**. With the information shared, and programs inspired by the ORS, we are helping communities and individuals make **healthier, safer choices**.
