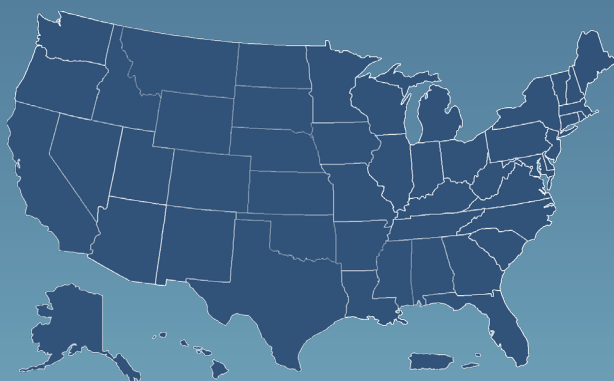
Through education and training, the ORS provides communities and partners with the knowledge and tools to **support overdose prevention, treatment and recovery**.
